

TITLE: SERVING HUMANKIND

VISUAL: EXT. L.A. COLISEUM FOOTBALL FIELD – DAY

VISUAL: An alien ship, looking like a 50-yard-long garden gnome, lands at mid field.

SUPER: The very near future... or even sooner.

SUPER: “Serving Humankind”

VISUAL: ALIENS, who look like 4’-tall living garden gnomes without hats, but with four eyes, descend on a ramp. They exchange high-fives with HUMANS, who board the ship.

VISUAL: INT. POLICE BRIEFING ROOM – DAY

VISUAL: CAPTAIN ANDRE MASON (40s) stands at a lectern in front of 20 sitting HUMAN MALE and FEMALE OFFICERS. MITCHELL CHAMBERS (40s) looks disgusted.

CAPT MASON: With more and more Galaxians visiting and relocating here – along with humans visiting Galaxia – it’s important that all of us – including you, Chambers – learn their language.

VISUAL: Chambers rolls his eyes.

CAPT MASON: Fortunately, we have a little help. Check under your seat.

VISUAL: Everyone pulls out “Rosetta Stone® for Galaxian.”

CAPT MASON: I’m told Galaxian is easier to learn than English.

CHAMBERS: Cap, who told you that, a Galaxian?

VISUAL: Everyone laughs – except the Captain.

CAPT MASON: Just learn it. And, yes, Galaxians are learning Earth languages. You guys should have invested in Rosetta Stone stock, like I did.

CAPT MASON: (glaring at Chambers) Make it a day to be proud.

VISUAL: EXT. TOWNHOUSE – NIGHT

VISUAL: A MALE and FEMALE GALAXIAN ring a DOORBELL.

VISUAL: Chambers, now in civilian clothes, opens the door.

VISUAL: The Galaxians' high-pitched, broken English and Galaxian speech is supported in subtitles:

MALE

GALAXIAN: Officer Chambers, we're your new neighbors and we'd love to have you over for dinner tomorrow night.

VISUAL: Chambers' eyes go wide.

FEMALE

GALAXIAN: Six p.m. No need to bring anything. We're in unit eight right there –

VISUAL: She points to the complex right across from his.

CHAMBERS: I'd love to go, but I have plans.

MALE and

FEMALE

GALAXIAN: No, you don't.

CHAMBERS: Well, okay.

VISUAL: Chambers closes the door. Places a call by touching a hi-tech Cicret Bracelet on his left arm. His left forearm becomes a touchscreen and he presses the phone icon. Sanchez's image appears on his forearm.

CHAMBERS: Sanchez, my Galaxian neighbors want to have me for dinner.

SANCHEZ: Did you take the Rosetta Stone course?

CHAMBERS: Not a chance.

SANCHEZ: Is it possible they invited you over for dinner?

CHAMBERS: Not a chance.

SANCHEZ: I'll inform the Captain. I'm sure he'll want to talk to you before we take any action.

VISUAL: EXT. TOWNHOUSE – EVENING

VISUAL: With Chambers in civilian clothes, a number of POLICE OFFICERS, including the Captain and Sanchez, stand outside the Galaxians' door. An OFFICER slams a police battering ram into the door, bashing it open.

VISUAL: INT. TOWNHOUSE – EVENING

VISUAL: Chambers, the Captain, Sanchez and the Police Officers rush in, guns drawn, disturbing three GALAXIAN COUPLES, the Galaxian Hosts (all on booster seats) – plus, gorgeous, female human guest GERDA WILHELM (30s).

CHAMBERS: (dreamy; directed at Gerda) Freeze?

FEMALE

GALAXIAN: Officer Chambers, we see you've brought your playmates over for dinner.

SANCHEZ: Over for dinner?

VISUAL: The Galaxians nod in unison.

CHAMBERS: Over?

GERDA: Yes, Officer Chambers. I'm Gerda Wilhelm. I was your intended blind date.

CHAMBERS: Umm, won't we have a great story to tell our kids?

VISUAL: FREEZE FRAME

SUPER: Vote for your favorite ending...

SUPER: Six Months Later

VISUAL: Chambers nods and points.

CHAMBERS: (in Galaxian, supported in subtitles) It's one of my favorite places. It's four blocks up. Third establishment on your left-appendage side.

GALAXIAN

MALE TEEN: (in English) Thank you.

CHAMBERS: (in Galaxian, supported in subtitles) My pleasure.

VISUAL: Gerda watches pleasantly stunned and impressed.

VISUAL: The Galaxian leaves on his hovering skateboard. Chambers sees Gerda and does a double take, catching Gerda's smile.

GERDA: Officer Chambers, have time for a donut?

CHAMBERS: With you, Ms. Wilhelm? Always.

VISUAL: They share a smile. They start walking and talking, getting closer and closer to each other...
